#### **ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE P. CAVANAGH:**

The Applicants seeks a Termination and Distribution Order which, among other things: (a) provides for the termination of these CCAA proceedings and the discharge of the Monitor upon the CCAA Termination Time (as defined in the materials; (b) approves the Monitor's Reports and the activities of the Monitor referred to therein; (c) approves the fees and disbursements of KPMG, in its capacity as Monitor and Proposed Monitor, and its counsel throughout the CCAA proceedings and the anticipated further fees and disbursements of the Monitor and its counsel required to complete the administration of the CCAA proceedings; (d) authorizes the Monitor, for and on behalf of the Applicants, to make the distributions for which authorization is requested; (e) authorizes Residual Co. to assign the Earnout (as defined in the materials) to Aviva pursuant to the Assignment Agreement; (f) authorizes the assignment of the Applicants into bankruptcy prior to the CCAA Termination Time and pursuant to the BIA, and authorizes and empowers KPMG to act as Trustee for each of the Applicant; (g) terminates the Charges (as defined) upon the CCAA Termination Time; (h) grants a release to the Monitor and its counsel and other released parties from any and all claims in relation to the CCAA proceedings; and (i) extends the Stay Period until the CCAA Termination Time.

I have reviewed the motion materials and heard submissions from counsel for the Applicants and counsel for the Monitor. There is no opposition. The Monitor supports the requested Order. I am satisfied that the requested Order should be made.
