

## Mauritius exits the FATF list of Jurisdictions Under Increased Monitoring

At its October 2021 Plenary, the Financial Action Task Force (FATF) concluded that Mauritius would no longer be subject to increased monitoring by the FATF.

The European Commission previously confirmed that removal of Mauritius from the FATF list of jurisdictions under increased monitoring will also lead to delisting of Mauritius from the European Union list of High-Risk Third Countries for AML/CFT purposes.

Despite the challenging COVID-19 situation, Mauritius managed to address the deficiencies identified by the FATF, well ahead of the agreed timeline of January 2022. This shows the commitment of the jurisdiction towards adhering to all the international tax and regulatory standards.
