Application requirements:

- Recent full face photograph
- Birth Certificate and/or Certificate of Caymanian Status
- Final cumulative high school and/or University transcript(s)
- Copy of acceptance letter into accredited University program
- Total cost of University attendance (tuition, room and board fees, insurance, etc.)
- CV/Resume
- Essay on, "Why I chose to pursue a higher education in business."
- Two letters of recommendation (i.e. academic and/or work experience)

Please note that the priority deadline for submission is February 1st, however all applications may be delivered to the KPMG office in the Cayman Islands until May 1st.

Local Scholarship Program

Value and duration

KPMG in the Cayman Islands will provide financial assistance, per standard tuition costs, to attend the University College of the Cayman Islands (UCCI). Sponsorship will include student fees, books and supplies as requisite. All payments are made directly to the college at the beginning of each term.

Qualifications

To apply, applicants:

- Must be Caymanian or hold Caymanian Status.
- Should be between the ages of 16 - 25 and must have the necessary background to achieve success at a competitive university.
- Should have received notice of acceptance from UCCI.
- Must possess a High School Diploma.
- Must have at least 5 IGCSE/GCSE/CXC passes with a grade C, 3, or higher. Four of those must be academic subjects (i.e. Mathematics, English, Science).
- Should provide their SAT results for math and critical reading scores of 900 minimal or ACT score of 19.
- Must have a minimal 3.0/4.0 scale cumulative grade point average.

Overseas Scholarship Program

Value and duration

KPMG in the Cayman Islands will provide financial assistance of up to US\$50,000 per year, for a maximum of five years. This is intended to be used toward standard tuition, student fees, books and supplies, flights, and room and board as needed. All payments will be made directly to the school and flights will be reimbursed upon approval.

Qualifications

To apply, applicants:

- Must be Caymanian or hold Caymanian Status.
- Should be at least 17 years of age and must have the necessary background to achieve success at a competitive university.
- Should have received notice of acceptance by an approved and fully accredited educational institution overseas offering undergraduate degrees.
- Must possess a High School Diploma and have at least 5 IGCSE/GCSE/CXC passes with a grade B, 2, or higher or equivalent passes in home country dictated by their governing Board of Education or Ministry and/or hold an Associate's degree with a GPA of 3.0 or higher from a regionally accredited university or community college.
- Should provide their SAT results for math and critical reading scores of 900 minimal or ACT score of 19.

Selection process

- Applicants will be required to undergo an aptitude test administered by KPMG in the Cayman Islands.
- Applicants will be required to attend an interview with the Board of Directors of the Novelette A. Ebanks Inspirational Scholarship. Interviews are usually conducted between April and May.
