On 14 October 2019, the International Finance Department of Taiwan published an updated version of the CRS XML Element Table and CRS XML Element Table Related XML Schema.

Additionally, on 09 October 2019, the International Finance Department of Taiwan published updated versions of the Self-certification forms (Entity, Individual and Persons with Control) and Declaration forms (Annual tax use financial account information declaration and Notification requirements).
