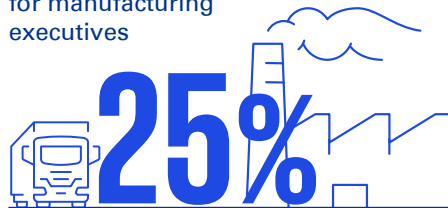


Shifting customer demands and disruptive technologies are transforming the manufacturing sector.

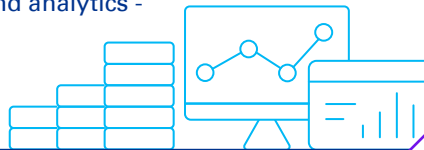

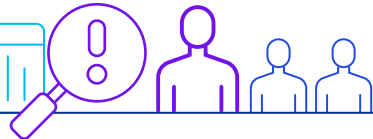

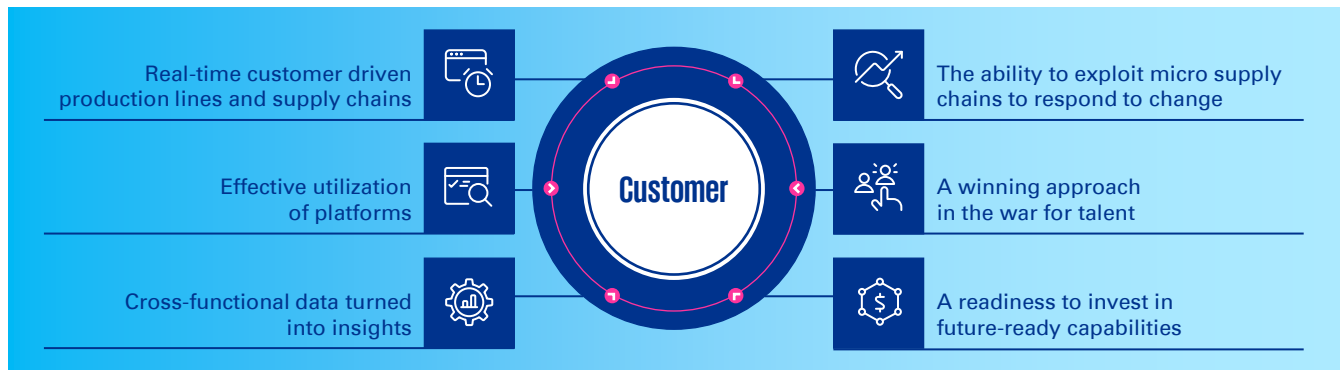
